



What to Do If Your Pet is Missing

- Email the Clermont County Animal Shelter:
 - dogwarden@clermontcountyohio.gov
 - kennel@clermontcountyohio.gov
- Search online networks and databases to see if someone has posted about your pet
- Post details online about your missing pet
- Check local veterinary offices
- Check local pet stores
- Hang "Lost Pet" hardcopy fliers in the area where your pet went missing

Tips for Creating a “Missing Pet” Flier

Be sure to include:

- Clear photo(s) of your pet
- Date your pet went missing
- Last known location and zip code
- Your contact information

Remember

- Once your pet is found, please update or remove your original fliers and social media posts so everyone knows the status.
- Never give up hope! Some animals are reunited years after they have gone missing.
